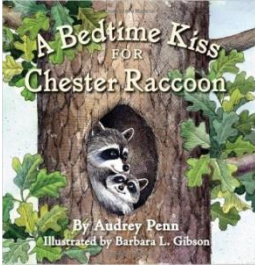




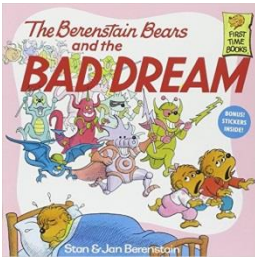

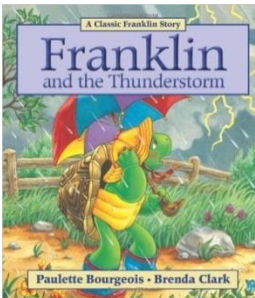
When Chester the raccoon goes to bed at sunrise, the shadows cast in his room are frightening and keep him from falling asleep. – *Sarasota County Library*

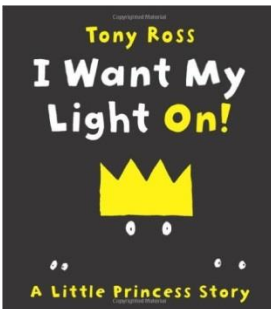

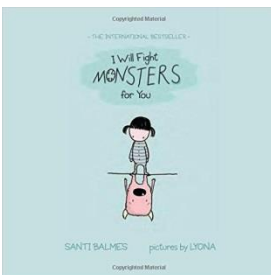

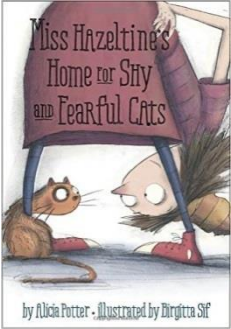


I Will Fight Monsters for You

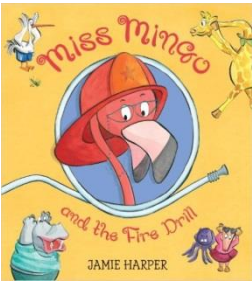

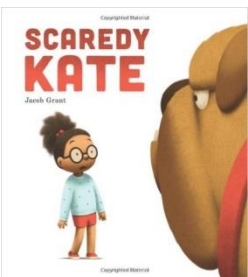

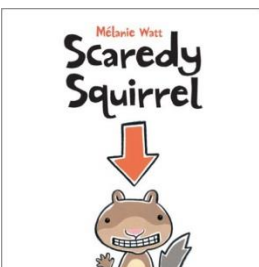
