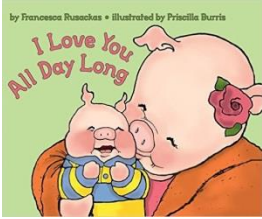




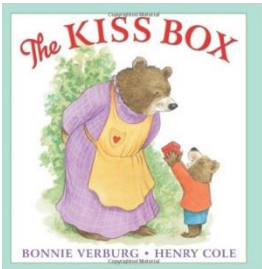

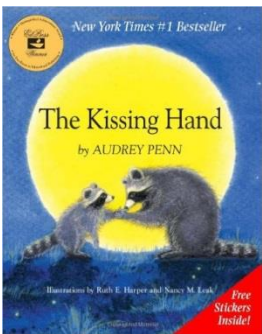
When a little pig worries about being apart from his mother when he goes off to school, she reassures him. – *Sarasota County Library*

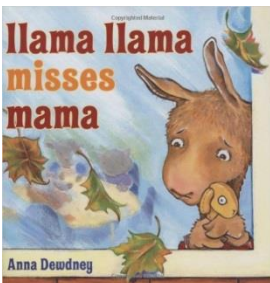

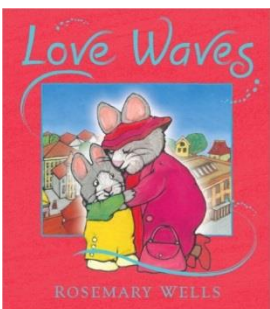

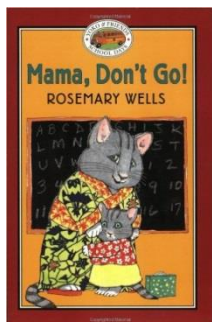


Love Waves

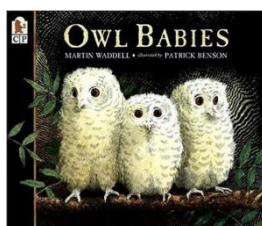

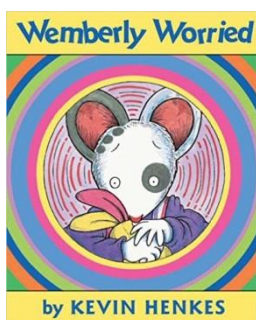

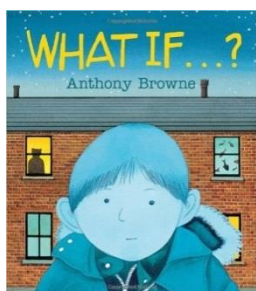
